Light Horse Show Rules

- 1. Entries may be done online, emailed, mailed or phoned in by June 8, 2025.

Post Entries will be accepted up to one hour before the start of the show @ \$10.00/ class with no day rate.

- **2**. Entry fee is \$5.00/class or \$25.00 for unlimited classes per horse/rider combo. If you are riding multiple horses, each horse must have a separate entry and back number. If you add or change classes after your entry form has been submitted, you will be charged a post entry fee of \$10.00.
- **3**. A deposit of \$5.00 **CASH** will be charged on back numbers at the event, which will be refunded when the number is turned in.
- **4.** No entry fee will be charged for classes 14 and 15, but riders may not enter in any other classes (except gymkhana, and costume).
- **5.** Show will go rain or shine unless the show committee deems it unsafe to continue. **Entry money is only refunded if the Horse Show is cancelled.** If the date needs to be moved until later summer or September due to adverse weather conditions, there is a possibility of running out of daylight. If that happens, we will continue the program until darkness makes it unsafe to do so and then the last events will be cancelled. If you have entered classes that are cancelled, we will refund your entry money for those cancelled classes; however, if you have paid a day rate, and have completed other classes, no refund will be given.
- **6**. Age groups will be split as follows (age is determined as of show day):

Senior - 18 years and up **Junior** - 13 to 17 years **Peewee** -12 years and under Classes may be cancelled or combined if less than three entries.

- **7**. Juniors may not ride stallions.
- **8.** Only one exhibitor is allowed per horse in the same class.
- **9**. Points must be earned by the same horse to be eligible for high point award.
- 10. Unruly horses will be excused from the ring.
- **11**. Appropriate tack, equipment, and attire are necessary. Properly fitted helmets are **MANDATORY** for Juniors and Peewees.
- **12.** Exhibitors must have their horses in the hitching ring five minutes before their class starts.
- **13.** Patterns will be posted for equitation, showmanship, and utility horse classes one hour before class starts.
- 14. The Bezanson Horse Show is a learning show, and some coaching is needed for inexperienced riders. However, excessive coaching and harassment of the judge, other riders or organizers will not be tolerated.
- **15.** Ribbons and prize money/or equal value prize, will be awarded as follows:

16. Points for each ribbon awarded will be as follows:

1^{st}- 10 points 2^{nd}- 7 points 3^{rd}- 5 points 4^{th}- 3 points.
```

17. All Awards will be presented at the end of the day.

Please Note:

- Horses and trailers are <u>NOT</u> to be located in the immediate area of the Legion Hut, the gazebo, or immediately in front of the Centre.
- Holding area will be on the **NORTH** end of the ring. Enter by the north gate, except for Showmanship classes, which will enter by the south gate.
- Warm-up area is to the north/east of the ring.
- There are to be no horses at the east side of the ring where the grandstand and spectators are located.
- You are responsible for ensuring that you leave your area clean and free of manure, hay and shavings when you leave the Horse Show.

Order of Events & Description of Classes

MORNING - Light Horse Classes Begin at 9am sharp.

Showmanship - Horses to be shown in hand, handler is judged on their ability to show horse and on the appearance of the horse, i.e.: grooming and condition. Handler must be dressed appropriately. Open to both light and heavy horses.

- 1. Showmanship Peewee (English or Western attire) SPONSORED BY Fenton Greenhouses
- 2. Showmanship Junior (English or Western attire) SPONSORED BY Keddie's Tack & Western Wear
- 3. Showmanship Senior (English or Western attire) SPONSORED BY Mac Force Services

Utility Horse- Horse and rider must negotiate simple obstacles such as may be encountered day to day. Class is timed.

- 4. Utility Horse- English or Western Peewee SPONSORED BY Semerra Oilfield Services
- 5. Utility Horse- English or Western Junior SPONSORED BY Semerra Oilfield Services
- 6. Utility Horse- English or Western Senior- SPONSORED BY Semerra Oilfield Services
- 7. Western Pleasure Peewee **SPONSORED BY** Fenton Greenhouses
- 8. Western Pleasure Junior SPONSORED BY Bezanson General Store
- 9. Western Pleasure Senior SPONSORED BY Hick Steeds

Western Pleasure Walk/Jog - cannot be cross entered with loping classes, except for Gymkhana and Showmanship of appropriate age group.

10. Western Pleasure Walk/Jog – Open- SPONSORED BY - Ritchie Bros Auctioneers

Western Horsemanship- Rider to be judged on seat, hands, ability to control and show horse. Results shown are not considered more important than the method used by the rider to get results. Individual tests may be required at judge's discretion.

- 11. Western Horsemanship Peewee SPONSORED BY Ritchie Bros Auctioneers
- 12. Western Horsemanship Junior SPONSORED BY Bezanson General Store
- 13. Western Horsemanship Senior SPONSORED BY Keddie's Tack & Western Wear

- 14. Lead-line- 8 years and under SPONSORED BY West Smoky Legion
- 15. Pony and Pal (Walk/trot only, may not enter other classes, except costume, and gymkhana) SPONSORED
- BY West Smoky Legion

English Pleasure- To be judged on manners, performance, quality, and conformation, in that order. The horse shall give the appearance of being a pleasure to ride.

- **16.** English Pleasure Peewee **SPONSORED BY** Ritchie Bros Auctioneers
- 17. English Pleasure Junior SPONSORED BY Keddie's Tack & Western Wear
- 18. English Pleasure Senior SPONSORED BY Dale and Judy Loewen Farms

English Pleasure Walk/Trot - cannot be cross entered with loping classes, except for Gymkhana and Showmanship of appropriate age group.

19. English Pleasure Walk/Trot – Open - SPONSORED BY – Mac Force Services

English Equitation- Basic Seat, judged on the rider. To be shown at walk, trot, and canter in both directions. Individual tests may be required at the judge's discretion.
